## **ORDER**

As per the Government Order read above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for starting to new Self-financing courses/Additional Batch in various self financing colleges affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University for the academic year 2020-21. Managements of the Education Institutions have executed agreement with Government which is read as 2nd paper above.

2. In the circumstances, Government are pleased to issue NOC for starting to new Self-financing courses/ Additional Batch in various self financing colleges affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University for the academic year 2020-21 as detailed below subject to the following conditions.

- The Educational Agency shall give an undertaking to the University about the presence of adequate infrastructure for conducting the course and the presence of adequate NET qualified faculty.
- ii. The Educational Agency shall abide by the procedure of admission as decided by the Government and set apart 50% of the seats of the course for being filled up by the Government or such authority determined by Government on the basis of merit and reservation principles followed by the Government and the remaining 50% filled up by the Educational Agency on the basis of merit.
- iii. The Educational Agency shall collect only such fees as determined by the Government from time to time from the students admitted to the college for the course.
- iv. The Educational Agency shall institute adequate number of scholarships on merit cum means basis as determined by the Government from time to time to the students admitted to the course.
- v. The Educational Agency shall maintain a website and publish the details regarding the establishment and governance of the Educational Agency, admission, fees, courses, results, teaching and non-teaching staff, grievance redressal mechanism for students and any other information as required by Government.
- vi. The Educational Agency shall run only courses approved by the Government and the University concerned.
- vii. The Educational Agency shall enable the Government and its representatives to check, verify and monitor the compliance of the conditions mentioned above at anytime the Government decides so.
- vii. The No Objection Certificate/sanction granted shall be valid up to the end of the Academic year 2020-21 and renewable on the request of the Educational Agency

and subject to the satisfactory compliance of the conditions specified herein.

- 'iii. The service of the teaching and non-teaching staff of the aided stream shall not be utilized for the proposed unaided courses.
- iX. The College shall seek NAAC accreditation by the year 2022.
- X. There shall be no financial commitment to the Government for the proposed unaided course/ courses.
- Xi. In the event of breach of any of the conditions mentioned above by the Educational Agency, the Government is authorized to withdraw the sanction without notice to the Educational Agency, or adjudicate the quantum of compensation which the Educational Agency is liable to pay to Government, if any, and upon such adjudication, the Educational Agency should pay to Government the amount so fixed, failing which the amount of compensation adjudicated should be recoverable under the provision of Kerala Revenue Recovery Act, 1968, as if they were public revenue due on land.
- xii. The Educational Agency shall produce necessary documents for the continued affiliation from the University for the year 2020-21 before 31/03/2021 failing which the sanction issued will be treated as cancelled w.e.f.01/04/2021 and Government will not be responsible for any loss incurred by the institution and the institutions shall be solely responsible for the losses thereof.
- xiii. The College shall apply for renewal of NOC by March every year.
